## No cruises are available from May 13 to July 21, 2013

- Divers can expect three dives per day including occasional night and sunrise dives. Our legal obligations require presentation of dive certification card and logbook prior to diving. Divers require medical clearance and our in-house doctor is available for medical screening if required. A 24-hour no dive policy is observed for guests who intend to travel by air (including seaplane).
